**INSTRUCTIONS  
FOR THE APPLICATION OF THE METHODOLOGY ON THE CONDUCT OF  
THE TEACHING PROCESS IN THE SECOND SEMESTER,  
ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-2021**

- Courses for bachelor's degree programs can be conducted online or on-site, in compliance with all epidemiological protection regulations in force at the date of the course. In cases of high epidemiological risk (for example: state of alert, placement of the county in the red zone, etc.), it is recommended, to the extent permitted, to carry out online courses. All optional courses should be carried out online.
- The maximum number of participants in an on-site course is 50 people (including teaching staff). The maximum number of participants may change over time, depending on the regulations in force.
- Courses in the master's degree, doctoral and the Lugoj and Deva General Medical Assistance study programs will take place exclusively online.
- The project assignments, laboratories, seminars, clinical internships will be carried out on-site with the distribution of the number of participating students at the same time and in the same location (laboratory/seminar/course rooms, clinical wards) so as to observe the sanitary rules in force during the pandemic. In case of splitting a class, the practical activities will be carried out either by halving the time for a laboratory/seminar/internship, or by the alternating attendance of students and performance of two practical activities in the time allocated to one. Supplementation of the time will be done through the individual study of the teaching materials made available online on the e-learning platforms (Moodle, e-book). These measures aim to provide a high degree of safety to teaching staff and students while maintaining effective, non-discriminatory access to the on-site teaching process. Exceptions to the on-site performance of clinical internships are the disciplines whose activity takes place in COVID wards as of 15 February 2021. In these cases, the teaching activity will take place in auditoria/rooms, in the form of clinical case presentations.
- The project assignments, laboratories, seminars, clinical internships for master's degree and doctoral study programs will be carried out exclusively online.
- Foreign students who will not be able to attend the on-site teaching activity, in the epidemiological context, will inform the Deanships on this aspect, and will continue the activity online through individual study on e-learning platforms (Moodle, e-learning book); also, at the end of the quarantine or lockdown period, they will fill in the Individual Study Form for the period in which they were absent (available on the UMFVBT website).
- The provision of personal protective equipment for on-site clinical teaching activities (clinical internships) is the responsibility of the students, and consists of: medical textile gown, medical clogs, surgical mask, and gloves (as appropriate) for the study programs of the Faculty of Medicine, and medical textile gown, medical clogs, surgical mask, gloves, and, additionally, goggles or visor for the study programs of the Faculty of Dentistry.

- With respect to the regulations provided in the Methodology on the organisation and conduct of the online/hybrid/on-site teaching process within the “Victor Babeș” University of Medicine and Pharmacy in Timișoara (UMFVBT),
    - The gloves will be provided by UMFVBT, and are mandatory only when performing dissections in the discipline of Anatomy and when performing dental manoeuvres.
    - Each discipline within the Faculty of Dentistry will have 10 pairs of goggles.
    - Disinfectants will be provided by UMFVBT in all teaching spaces of the University.
    - In the event that a discipline requires additional protective equipment, in addition to that provided by legal regulations and the Methodology on the organisation and conduct of the online/hybrid/on-site teaching process, the provision of equipment will be the responsibility of that discipline. Failure to provide the required additional equipment cannot be a reason for students not to participate in internships.
